Our 100% pure and natural pink peppercorn essential oil is produced from schinus molle from Peru. Schinus molle is often confused with a similar species, schinus terebinthifolius, native to the Indian Ocean region .

Native to Central and South America, pink peppercorn or Schinus molle is a small, graceful tree with a dense, drooping appearance. It bears small, white, delicately scented flowers before producing the bright-red, fleshy fruits known as pink peppercorns. The false pepper tree embellishes perfume compositions with its spicy, woody fragrance with pleasantly peppery notes.
